Joint meeting with the City Council, City Park Committee, and CAPRD Board.

The meeting was held to provide the City Council with an update on CAPRD progress toward a 2010 tax base election. The discussion included CAPRD and Clackamas Co. Park district, pros and cons. We discussed the need for a community center and the replacement of the existin swimming pool. There were example concerning the current operating levee for the pool, and the potential rate per thousand of a tax base from either the county or CAPRD. Concerns were raised about continuing to vote on a pool operating levee, and if the county park rate per thousand was sufficient to cover both the pool, and existing park maintenance and development.

The City dilemma is the lack of funding to support parks from the current budget, and the need to find new sources of revenue.
