CAPRD Meeting Minutes

April 10, 2008

Previous meetings minutes were approved with one correction. At previous City/CAPRD meeting Liz Thorstenson was listed instead of Liz Mead as attending in error.

Treasurers Report:

Don Morgan reported on our efforts to have the Canby Herald provide the required listing of our meeting times and dates. He also talked about Clackamas County's plans for the park on the Molalla River at Knights Bridge.

Liz presented information on our web site, and how we can post new information, and prepare a contact page for citizens to get on our E-mail lists. We discussed starting a blog, an area for a community forum, and an area for E-news.

Janie recapped the facility tour, and presented a recommendation to move forward with a consultant on a design similar to the facility at Portland's SW Community Center in Gabriel Park. We discussed posting picture of the various facilities we visited, along with an explanation of what we thought was appropriate for our area and needs. We talked about broadcasting an E-mail letter about our process and recommendations of core elements for Canby.

We also discussed additional ball field needs and athletic facilities for kids that might be developed with the community center. We are going to contact Canby Kids for their input on our current inventory of field, what additional needs they foresee, and the likelihood of the turf field project proceeding at the High School.

It was suggested that we begin to meet with PTA's at the end of this school year, and continue to plan on a stakeholders meeting in May with the City Parks Committee.
