CAPRD Meeting Minutes

July 10, 2008

Previous meetings minutes were approved as presented.

Treasurers Report, \$1712.99 in bank.

Bev Doolittle, of the Chamber of Commerce signed off on our final grant report submitted by Board Member Janie Malloy.

Chair Milne reported on the stakeholders meeting that was held last month. Input remained consistent on items that the community felt we needed to include in our planning. Primarily additional sport fields, supports for existing recreation providers, and a solution for the swimming pool maintenance and replacement issues.

Matilda Deas has scheduled a meeting on July 15 with representatives from the YMCA. They remain interested in creating a partnership with CAPRD.

It was suggested that we make a short presentation to the City Council at their next meeting to update them on our progress to date. Chair Milne and Board Member Driggers volunteered to attend the August 6 City Council meeting.

Board Member Morgan updated us on the County's Molalla River Park, and shared how the County had sited four sports field adjacent to the senior center and his view of how positive that had developed.

The Board discussed additional opportunities for media exposure. Board Member Malloy contacted the Canby Herald, and pitched a story covering local swimmer Morgan Scroggins who competed at the USA Olympic Trials. The Herald ran two articles on Morgan Scroggins. The Fun Run is proceeding on schedule, and Chair Milne has been attending the organizational meetings.
