## **Legacy Park's moment is here**

Dedication ceremony set for Saturday morning

Canby Mayor Melody Thompson will dedicate the completion of Legacy Park on Saturday, July 18 at 10 a.m. at the picnic shelter.

Located at 1200 SE 13th Ave., Legacy Park was named to recognize the many contributions of citizens and organizations involved in its development.

It is a six-acre park that has been developed in phases as funding and other resources became available over the last five years.

The park includes two soccer fields, two playgrounds, a walking path, magnolia grove, parking lot, restroom and picnic shelter.

“The mayor recently read a proclamation declaring July to be Park Month in the city of Canby and so it is fitting that the newly completed park be dedicated this month,” said Mark Adcock, city administrator.

Cookies and coffee will be available and members of the Canby Area Park and Recreation District will also be present with park bumper stickers. The city’s Park Advisory Board will have maps of Canby’s parks available for those who would like to explore the city’s park system further.
